

# DAIRY CATTLE – HOLSTEIN

**TAMPERING WITH CATTLE:** Unnatural practices in fitting will not be tolerated. All cattle entered for competition shall be presented in the judging ring in their natural conformation and natural physical condition.

**DAIRY EXHIBITORS:** Regulations for showing dairy cattle from Canadian Dairy Breeds will apply.

**BREEDING ABILITY:** In cases where doubt exists in the mind of the judge or official as to the breeding ability of any animal, the exhibitor may be required to furnish evidence to the satisfaction of the official concerned.

It is recommended that all Beef and Dairy animals be vaccinated with a broad spectrum vaccine. Check with your veterinarian for the one suited for you.

The above Rules are **IN ADDITION** to the general **Rules and Regulations at the front of this book.**

Exhibitors are responsible for reading and abiding by them.

- Please submit signed Standard Exhibitor's Agreement with entry forms.
- **MOVE IN TIME:** All animals and exhibits must be in place by 8 a.m. Friday morning except non-livestock exhibits, which must be in place by 6 p.m. Thursday evening. All vehicles must be parked in designated parking areas by Friday 8:30 a.m. or they will be towed at the owner's expense.
- Release time is Saturday evening, August 12.
- Please have registration certificates available upon arrival, as cattle **MUST** be checked that evening. This includes ALL animals entered in the open show. (includes 4-H)
- No applications for registration or photocopies of registration certificates will be accepted as proof of registration. **NO PAPERS – NO SHOW!**
- Please include Registration numbers on Entry Forms.
- All exhibits must be registered in the name of the exhibitor in accordance with the bylaws of their respective association. The certificate of registration must state that the animal is purebred or at least 75% of purebred inheritance. NIP papers will **NOT** be accepted.

**NUMBER OF EXHIBITS PER BREEDING UNIT:** The maximum number of exhibits per breeding unit is unlimited. The 2017 Chilliwack Fair will follow the National Regulations regarding the calculation for a Minor or Country Show regarding the points towards premier breed and exhibitor.

**MULTIPLE EXHIBITS:** No restriction on multiple exhibits.

**SUBSTITUTIONS** in the same class can be made up to the time of arrival at the Fair, at the Entry Office. Additional entry fee required.

**How to Enter a Show Fleece:** Determine which class of wool you will enter and complete the Fleece Show Registration Form. After payment is processed the form will be forwarded to the show coordinator.

**Preparing Fleeces for the show:** Each fleece should be skirted (belly, tags and dags out), folded, rolled with the shorn side out, starting from britch, and rolling toward the shoulder and placed in a clear plastic bag.

**Fleece Identification Form:** Available in prize book, from Event Coordinator or on website. Do not tape it to the outside of the bag. Place it inside the bag with print facing out.

**Drop off Fleeces:** Thursday evening or Friday, August 11 before 11 a.m. There will be a designated area in the sheep section.

**Classes and Entries:** Classes must have at least 3 fleeces entered by at least 2 producers in order to be judged. Classes will be combined if necessary to meet this requirement. Maximum of 3 fleeces per class allowed per producer.

**Pick up your fleeces:** Should be picked up no later than 3 p.m. Sunday, August 13. Any fleeces not picked up by the deadline will be dealt with at the discretion of the show organizers.

**Judging:** Each show is judged as a handspinner/artisan show. Fleeces are judged for soundness, cleanliness

including yield, luster, as well as handle, staple length, crimp style and uniformity characteristic to the breed. The Show Judge and organizers have complete discretion regarding disqualification or re-classing of any fleece and general conduct of show. Will take place on Friday, August 11 at 1 p.m.

**Spinner's Choice Award:** will be awarded on Saturday afternoon with Supreme class.

- No livestock may enter through the front door of Building 3 (main entrance) at any time.
- No animals may be taken into the washrooms. Please keep washrooms clean.
- All animals must be under the control of a handler at all times, and no animals permitted to defecate on site without immediate clean up.
- Use of duct tape is not allowed. Please use clear hockey tape or tape purchased from Heritage Park office. Do not use staples, nails, or tacks.
- Helium balloons are not permitted.



- Release time is Sunday, August 13 at 5 p.m.
- All birds must be PUREBRED and breed name and variety must appear on entry forms. If Breed and/or variety do not appear on this list, please write the complete description on your entry form.
- All exhibits must be in good health.

## GENERAL RULES & REGULATIONS

- The show will be judged under the latest rules of the American Poultry Association Standard of Perfection.
- The Superintendent and his assistants will be allowed in the judging area while judging is in progress; this area will be under the control of the Superintendent at all times.
- The Chilliwack Fair reserves the right to put more than one specimen in one coop, providing that the birds belong to the same Exhibitor.
- During the show, the Superintendent will have full charge of all exhibits, and they may not be removed from the show building without his/her written consent.
- No exhibitor will be allowed to handle any but his/her own exhibits.
- All eggs laid during the show will have fertility destroyed and become the property of Chilliwack Fair.
- All birds will be fed and watered by staff.
- Any exhibit showing disease or lice/mites will not be allowed in the show building.
- No exhibitor will be allowed to coop or pack for shipment any exhibit unless accompanied by the Superintendent or one of his assistants.
- Management reserves the right to decide any point not covered by the rules and to correct any error or make any necessary alterations to the prize list.
